- c) On the recommendations of the Hospital Medical Board, Claim / Bill in respect of cases mentioned at (b) above shall be decided by Executive Director, Capital Hospital, Financial Advisor /Member and Chairman, CDA, according to the Financial Powers entrusted to them under item No.68 of Revised Schedule of Financial Powers-2007.
- d) On the recommendations of the Hospital Medical Board, One time Ex-post facto approvals of all the pending claims as detailed at par 12 of the summary shall be made by the respective competent authority subject to the condition that the treatment was done in an emergency.
- e) Reimbursement of claimed amount / cost will be restricted to the maximum limit of approved Government rates or actual expenditure, whichever is less, keeping in view the nature of disease and treatment e.g. post OP cases.
- f) The medical claim of officers / officials on deputation to CDA as well as their dependents shall be disposed of in the light of prevailing policy of respective Federal / Provincial Government or policy applicable upon CDA Employees, Whichever is beneficial to them.

# PLANNING PARAMETERS FOR ZONE 2, 4 & 5; ACCESS ROAD TO THE PRIVATE **HOUSING SCHEMES.**

### **DECISION**

The summary was presented by Member (P& D), CDA. The sponsors of the scheme gave a detailed presentation of their project before the Board. After due deliberations Board observed that the condition regarding minimum 60 feet access road as per CDA's Board decision dated 09/06/2017 cannot be relaxed for a single project. The traffic count from the Simly Dam road which is 3.5 kms from the project cannot be estimated based on a single project of 300 kanals. This would grow once other projects develop on this access road. Hence the Board observed that the sponsor must ensure presence of 60 feet access road for the project from the nearest arterial road as per Board's decision dated 09/06/2017. However, as per Board's decision the requirement for a 60 feet access road is for a 400 -700 kanals project. The Board further decided that the matter regarding access roads for projects less than 400 kanals needs to be examined and may be referred to Federal Master Plan Commission to examine the matter and submit its recommendations in this regard.
