Necessary cross-verification and due diligence be made to verify whether the letter has been issued from each one of the districts.

b. Initiation of necessary correspondence with the office of the Auditor General of Pakistan considering the Honorable Supreme Court Directions of 26 December 2018 to inquire about the findings of the Forensic Audit (in the case initiated).
