The Chairman, CDA also attended the meeting in capacity of the Chief Commissioner, ICT, Commissioner Rawalpindi Ex-officio Member and Mr. Nayyar Ali Dada Non-Executive Member of the Board did not attend the meeting. While, Mr. Ali Asghar Khan, Non-Executive Members did not attend the meeting as resignation has been forwarded by him on 14-04.2022.

4. In addition to the above, DG HRD CDA, E.D Capital Hospital, Director Roads (N) CDA, CCE(Civil) E-in-C, H.O FWO,CEO Park View City, Lawyer Park View City and Mr. Faraz Chaudhry Park View City attended their relevant agenda items of the meeting.

5. Meeting commenced with the recitation of "Holy Quran" by Syed Safdar Ali, Secretary CDA Board. Thereafter agenda items were taken up for discussion and following decisions were made:-

7.1 CONFIRMATION OF 5TH BOARD MEETING.

The board confirmed / endorsed the previous Board minutes / decisions of meeting (i.e. 5th Board Meeting -2022).

7.2 <u>11531/1396/BM/'22</u> <u>17-06-'22/7th</u>

REPORT OF COMMITTEE FOR REGULARIZATION OF SERVICE OF DAILY WAGES CONTRACT DPL EMPLOYEES WHOSE SERVICES WERE DISPENSED WITH IN LIGHT OF THE DECISION OF 1ST CDA BOARD MEETING FOR THE YEAR-2022 DATED 03-01-2022.

DECISION

The summary was presented by the DG(HRD), CDA. Besides briefing upon the contents, findings and recommendations etc. given in the report of the committee, the DG (HRD) apprised the Board that services of 141 daily wage, DPL, muster roll employees were dispensed with by CDA Board on the basis of findings / recommendations / report as submitted before the Board previously wherein certain facts, evidence & precedents etc. were overlooked as pointed out by the instant committee. Whereas, in case of some persons, a compassionate ground can be taken as those persons had served the authority for a reasonable period. He referred to the fact that CDA Board decision dated 21-01-2015 regarding increase in age limit for the post of OGMs was not taken into account earlier while formulating recommendations regarding sixty four (64) OGMs which resulted in dispensing with of their services being overage. The services of another forty five (45) persons were also dispensed with being overage, while precedents regarding grant of age relaxation (for which CDA Board is duly competent) were available. Three (3) of them were not regularized mistakenly though they fulfilled all the requirements and six (6) persons on the basis that their complete record was not placed before the respective DRC. To not regularize services of eight (8) persons whose typing tests were not conducted by the Authority responsible for it does not seem justified. The remaining sixteen (16) persons whose services were dispensed with on the basis that regular or sanctioned posts were not available for them or they possess lower than requisite qualification, their cases may be considered on compassionate grounds and adjusted against newly created posts or overall strength of the Authority for which they are eligible.

On the basis of information in the summary, report of the committee, issue raised by the DG (HRD) and after thorough discussion & deliberation by the Board, the Board observed that aforementioned facts / evidence floating on the surface of record were not considered earlier while dispensing with the services of above 141 daily wage, DPL, muster roll employees. This necessitates the Board to consider said facts / evidence afresh and on the basis of proper appreciation of those facts / evidence to review its earlier decision of dispensing with the services of said 141 daily wages. DPL, Muster roll employees, for justice & fair play. The Board after due consideration of all the above facts & evidence etc. principally agreed with the findings / recommendations of the committee and decided to approve in principal the regularization of the services of 141 daily wages. DPL, Muster role persons whose services were earlier dispensed with on the recommendations / findings of previous DRC(s), subject to the condition that such regularization shall be made after due process by respective DRC(s) as a one-time dispensation in pursuance to Islamabad High Court decision in Writ Petition No.4604/2018 titled "Muhammad Ziaraf etc, ICA No. 155/2018 in WP. 2045/2017 titled Bin Yameen Masih, 2019 ICA No. 340/2017 dated 21-6-2018 ", keeping in view the following: -

- i- CDA Board decision dated 21-01-2015 shall be notified without any further delay.
- ii- In case of non-availability of regular / sanctioned post in said cadre, the person should be considered for an equivalent rank / post on overall strength of the Authority based on eligibility of the person in the light of recommendation of respective DRC,
- iii- Where deemed necessary by respective DRC, regular posts in the cadre may be created after due legal process and with the approval of the competent authority.

<u>DECISION</u>

No summary was presented to the Board. It was apprised to the board and discussed during the meeting that the Margallah Road is 33km long; from G.T. Road to Bhara Kahu and the same is part of Islamabad's Master Plan. The construction work on Phase-I of Margallah Road (from GT Road to D-12) is near completion as over 70 percent work has already been completed. However, the contractor has been facing an issue in the area due to the grave yard. In the second phase.08 km long Bhara Kahu bypass will be constructed from Murree Road near Qauid i Azam University to Satra Meel.

A presentation on the Alignment of Margallah Road Phase –I and Phase- II was made to the CDA Board by the CCE (Civil) E-in-C and H.O FWO. After due deliberation and on

- a) Proposed alignment of Margallah Road Phase –I and Phase- II in the presentation.
- b) To save the old graveyard, realignment or shifting of the Margallah Road Phase –I towards the Southern side of Sector C-13, Sector D-12.
- c) Estate Wing to start the process of compensation of those, whose houses will fall in the new alignment.
- d) Request will be made to E-N-C Branch for completion of BUP survey.
- e) Compensation will be made based on accurate survey of BUPs as a complete housing unit with independent utilities connection and not on the basis of each room with 300 sq ft which is not in accordance with the Rehabilitation Policy in vogue.
- f) Quaid-i-Azam University's land falling in the alignment of the Bhara Kahu bypass Road in Phase- II will be swapped with the available CDA's land in the area.
- g) Design of Margallah Road Phase –II will be optimized and high speed access controlled facilities will be kept in mind during designing of Margallah Road Phase –II.
- h) All conflicts arising during designing of Margallah Road Phase –II will be resolved first.
- i) Instead of planning of interchange at G.T Road intersection linked to Margallah Road, Staggered-U-Turns will be constructed in addition to widening of road; however, E-N-C Branch is requested to submit conceptual design of G.T Road intersection with cost to CDA Board.
- j) Link roads will be developed from G.T Road and Bhara Kahu links at Motorway and Muree Road, respectively. E-N-C Branch will prepare concept linkages for same in 02 week for consideration of the Board.
- k) A team under the Chairmanship of Mr. Iftikhar Husain Arif, Non-Executive Member CDA Board be constituted to explore the local history of Islamabad City, so that Islamabad old history could be represented for the knowledge of General Public. In this regard, the Vice Chancellor Quaid–i-Azam University, Islamabad had volunteered that a dedicated team of students of Anthropology Faculty / Department of Quaid–i-Azam University, Islamabad will be deputed to explore the local history of Islamabad City.
