The Chairman, CDA also attended the meeting in capacity of the Chief Commissioner, ICT, Mr. Naveed Ilahi, Member (Estate)/ Member (P&D), CDA, Executive Member and Mr. Nayyar Ali Dada, Non-Executive Member attended the meeting online. Commissioner Rawalpindi Ex-officio Member did not attend the meeting. While, Mr. Ali Asghar Khan, Non-Executive Members did not attend the meeting as his resignation dated 14-04.2022 has been referred for approval.

3. In addition to the above, representative/CEO of Park View Housing Society along with Counsel, DDG(Estate),CDA, DFA-II,CDA, Director(Housing Society),CDA, Director (Urban Planning),CDA and PD(BRT) attended their relevant agenda items of the meeting.

4. Meeting commenced with the recitation of "Holy Quran" by Syed Safdar Ali, Secretary CDA Board. Thereafter agenda items were taken up for discussion and following decisions were made:-

9.1 <u>CONFORMATION OF 6^{TH} BM & 7^{TH} BM – 2022.</u>

The board confirmed / endorsed the previous Board minutes / decisions of meetings (i.e. $6^{th} \& 7^{th}$ Board Meeting -2022).

9.2CONCEPTUAL PLAN OF COMMERCIAL PROJECT TITLED ORCHARD HEIGHTS11545/1399/BM/228ARK ROAD ISLAMABAD

29-07-'22/9th

DECISION

The summary was presented by the Director (H.S), CDA. It was apprised to the Board that the project was designed to utilize available land for potential commercial use in order to generate revenue. A site measuring 200 kanals was identified along park road adjacent to Orchard Scheme and King Hammad Nursing University, near park enclave. Proposal along with feasibility of commercial plots and plot of Mall along with State of the Art Apartment Complex was presented which was in accordance with the standards of Town Planning and the bye-laws framed under Building Control Regulations 2020. After due deliberation and information / input of the summary, the Board decided the following.

He briefed the Board that the proposed scheme comprises of an area over 3000 kanals and will provide residential, commercial plots of various sizes. After due deliberation and information / input /discussion, the Board decided the following.

However, on receipt of Court orders on 22.07.2022, the matter has again been placed before the Board. Accordingly, a hearing opportunity has been afforded to the representatives of M/S Park View Housing

Society (Pvt) Ltd along with their counsel/ lawyer to delineate their point of view. Representatives of M/S Park View Housing Society (Pvt) Ltd along with his counsel/ lawyer appeared and presented their case in detail before the CDA Board. During discussion representatives of M/S Park View Housing Society (Pvt) Ltd offered that they will deposit the cost of road and CDA may construct the road.

After due deliberation and on the basis of information / inputs / point of view of the representatives as well as Counsel / Lawyer of M/S Park View Housing Society (Pvt) Ltd, the Board has decided to comply with the Honorable Supreme Court order dated 09.06.2022 subject to the conditions of the final outcome of the report of Deputy Commissioner, ICT Administration regarding land acquisition and status of ownership of private land. Moreover, M/S Park View Housing Society (Pvt) Ltd will bear the actual cost for the construction of said road.

Moreover, a report be sought from the Deputy Commissioner, ICT Administration regarding land acquisition and status of ownership of private land and the same will be communicated to the Honorable Supreme Court of Pakistan in implementation of the orders and therefore, disposing of the matter by Planning Wing
