The summary was presented by the Member (Estate) and Member (Finance), CDA. It was apprised to the board that 1395. Acre land was allotted to NARC in 1975 for a period of 30 years @ Rs. 100 per acre per annum. The 1st term of the lease expired on 01-05-2005. Lease was further extendable for subsequent two terms and the new rate of lease extension was to be determined by CDA, On expiry of first term. It was requested to quarter concerned to deposit the outstanding dues from time to time but as per record the amount of lease extension and other charges was not deposited.

During year 2018, Costing Section, Finance Wing, CDA calculated lease extension charges at par with P&V scheme agro farms, but NARC did not agree with the amount demanded and requested that the charges may be rationalized on account of lease extension and AGR. Chairman CDA constituted a two member committee comprising of Member (Finance) and DG (Law) to classify the land for the purpose of ascertaining of lease amount for another term and Committee submitted its report. On perusal of report of the Committee, Chairman CDA directed that he matter may be deliberated in CDA Board.

After due deliberation and information / input on the summary, the board discussed both points of view and concluded that land allotted to NARC on leases basis falls under the domain of Agro Farming & Agro industry plots. AGR and delay charges on AGR had been calculated and demanded from NARC, as per prevailing ILDR-2005 as no separate classification of land has been given there under.

In view of the above, Board further decided that NARC may approach the Federal Government through the concerned ministry for either of the following options:-

a) Make a request to Federal Government for relaxation of rates of lease extension meant for Agro farms in respect of NARC/PARC as demanded by CDA.

OR

b) Arrange payment of outstanding amount of AGR and delay charges on AGR
